Item Summary: Lady Liberty Monument Relocation Project – CIP #172

**Project Scope:** The design and construction of a monument for the relocation of the Lady Liberty Statue and flag poles. The approved project site is located in the TxDOT Right of Way on the eastbound Frontage Road of US 80 and FM 688 as you enter Forney from the west.

Approved funding source – Community Betterment Fund (Luminant Contribution)

Estimated Project Cost \$265,000 (includes a 10% contingency)

Staff is requesting City Council approval to advertise for bid proposals for the construction of a new Lady Liberty Monument and Flag Poles.
